The We R Richmond Scholarship is available to a Richmond High School senior who plans to pursue an associate or bachelor’s degree at any accredited private or public university in Indiana. Applicants must have attended Richmond High School for at least three years.

As proud Richmond High School alumni, the scholarship donors want to reward well-rounded Richmond High School seniors with a GPA of 3.0 or higher who participated in extra-curricular activities at RHS and/or in the Richmond community and possibly held a part-time job(s) during the school year or summer. Selections from applicants are made by our Scholarship Committee, with the number of scholarships each dependent upon number and quality of applications and funds available from donors and sponsors. Six \$1,000 We R Richmond scholarships were awarded in 2022.
